## **Navigator and Adventurer's Camping Trip Budget**

As you fill this out, sometimes you will have an all inclusive/fixed cost such as \$150 for the campsite and it does not matter how many people go on the trip, it is still \$150. That number should just be entered on the "Line Total" Column. Other times, you will have a per person based expense like canoe rentals or Food. In that case enter the per person cost in the "Per Person Based Costs" column and then enter the multiple of the (Per Person Based Costs X Total Estimated Attendees) in the Line Total Column See Example below.
